During his reign of dominance in the 1970s, tennis legend Ilie Nastase had a little help from a friend: the double-strung racket. The model offered such a top-spin advantage that the sport was forced to issue its first restriction on equipment design. But while innovation often breeds success, not every racket comes up aces, as the collection of more than 500 models at the Augusta Tenniseum in Georgia makes clear. —LIZZIE HALDANE
